



This scholarship honors Brother Dan Buchan ('86), whose life exemplified ATO's core values of Leadership, Scholarship, Brotherhood, and Character. Dan's legacy of integrity, service, and friendship continues to inspire all who knew him.

A graduate of Washington & Jefferson College, Dan was an avid outdoorsman, devoted family man, and active community volunteer with the West Albany Fire Department. He faced his battle with brain cancer with remarkable courage and grace, leaving behind his wife Kym and daughters Hannah and Maggie.

With the blessing of the Buchan family, this scholarship will ensure Dan's spirit lives on by supporting deserving members of the Alpha Pi Chapter who embody his values. Our goal is to raise \$50,000 over five years to create a lasting endowment, funding both scholarships and leadership programs for active brothers.

Recipients will be selected annually by the Buchan family and the ATO Board of Trustees, with awards presented each spring at the ATO Senior Recognition Dinner.

Your contribution will help carry forward Dan's legacy of brotherhood, leadership, and character—ensuring that future generations of ATO brothers continue to lead and serve with the same heart that defined his life.
